Regarding permission to establish new schools on a self-financed basis for the academic year 2018-19 under the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012.

Introduction

A proposal was submitted to the Government for the recognition of **Al-Noor English Medium School, Chikhali, Taluka Haveli, District Pune**, managed by the **Anjuman Gausulwara Society, Pune**, to establish a new school on a self-financed basis. The matter of approving this proposal was under the consideration of the Government.

Government Decision

2.1 Under the Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools (Establishment and Regulation) Act, 2012, Government permission is hereby granted to the **Anjuman Gausulwara Society, Pune** to establish a new school: Al-Noor English Medium School, Chikhali, Tal. Haveli, Dist. Pune. This permission is for a new **Primary to Higher Secondary school (Std. 1st to 12th, all streams, English Medium, State Board)** starting from the academic year **2018-19**, subject to the fulfillment of the following terms and conditions:

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Financial Requirements:** The institution must submit an additional challan of **₹30,000/-** and copies of the audit reports for the preceding year to the concerned Divisional Deputy Director of Education within three months. Failure to comply within this period will result in the automatic cancellation of the school's recognition.
- 2. RTE Compliance:** The school must comply with all rules and provisions of the **Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009**.
- 3. Letter of Intent:** Permission (Letter of Intent) is granted to start the school in the 2018-19 academic year under the following conditions:
 - A)** If the management meets all government requirements, they must apply for first recognition to the District Education Officer within one month of the academic year's start.
 - B)** If all required facilities are not currently available, the management is bound to complete them and start the school within **eighteen months** from the date of this Government Resolution; otherwise, the permission will automatically lapse.
- 4. Legal Compliance:** The school is bound to follow all orders issued by the Government from time to time and all provisions of the **Maharashtra Self-Financed Schools Act, 2012**.
- 5. Verification:** Competent authorities must verify compliance with the 2009 Act before proceeding with first recognition.
- 6. No Changes Permitted:** No changes shall be made in the future regarding the medium of instruction or the location of the school. If the school is operated at a location other than the one approved, the permission will be automatically cancelled.
- 7. U-DISE Data:** The institution is responsible for registering the school in the **U-DISE** system under the separate category "Self-Financed Permitted School". A public notice board stating "New Self-Financed Permitted School" must be displayed at the school entrance.
- 8. Staff Recruitment:** Recruitment of teaching and non-teaching staff in the self-financed school must be done according to prevailing Government rules and policies.
